ASSIGNMENT OF COPYRIGHT

THIS AGREEMENT is an agreement between ("Engineers Australia") and (the "Licensor") the author/speaker for the EECON 2017

FOR THE BENEFIT OF:

The Institution of Engineers, Australia ABN 63 020 415 510 whose registered national office is at Engineering House, 11 National Circuit, Barton ACT 2600, trading as Engineers Australia ("**Engineers Australia**")

RECITALS

The Author owns the copyright in the Works and wishes to assign ownership of the copyright in the Works to Engineers Australia.

Engineers Australia wishes to accept the assignment on the following covenants.

OPERATIVE COVENANTS

Assignment

The Author assigns the copyright in the Works to Engineers Australia.

Author warranties

The Author warrants that:

- (a) the Works are original, have been written by the Author, have not been published elsewhere and are not encumbered or subject to any existing license;
- (b) the Works are not under consideration by any other publisher;
- (c) the Works do not infringe the rights of any third person;
- (d) to the best of the Author's knowledge the Works contain no defamatory or other unlawful statements;
- (e) the Author has obtained all the necessary permission (in writing) for the reproduction of Works, including any text or image;
- (f) all co-author(s) have, or have agreed to, execute this Deed.

Moral Rights

Engineers Australia must ensure that the Works are not subjected to any treatment which will infringe the moral rights of the Author.

Indemnity

The Author indemnifies Engineers Australia against any and all claims, demands, losses, damages and costs that Engineers Australia incurs or may incur as a result of a breach by the Author of the Author's obligations and warranties contained in this Deed.

General Terms of Publication

The parties acknowledge that the Author retains all Patent and trade mark rights and rights to any process or procedure described in the Works.

Engineers Australia grants to the Author a perpetual, royalty free license:

- (a) to include the Works in full or in part in a thesis or dissertation;
- (b) to photocopy or make electronic copies of the Works for personal use, including for their own classroom use, or for the personal use of colleagues;
- (c) to prepare derivative works,

provided that acknowledgement is made of Engineers Australia as publisher.

The Author may request Engineers Australia to consent to the granting of a licence for all uses not included above, including the authorisation of third parties to reproduce or otherwise use all or part of the Works (including figures and tables).

Applicable Law

This Deed is governed by the laws of the Australian Capital Territory, and the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of that jurisdiction.

Amendments

This Deed may not be varied except in writing signed by all the Author(s) and Engineers Australia.

Severability

If any provision of this Deed is held by a court to be unlawful, invalid or unenforceable it is to be severed so that the validity and enforceability of the remaining provisions are not affected.
